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### **Tell Your Story**

I set my own schedule. This has to be by far my favorite reason to write. Since the majority of my work is done from my laptop I am always available to get some writing in. Mondays happen to be my favorite day of the

week. I wake early, think about how grateful I am that I have nowhere to be and snuggle into the couch with my computer. I run my business primarily through social media. This means I've had to sharpen my skills in connecting with my audience through the written word. Social media is about words, images, audio and video. Writers also get to be role-models. My daughters look to me for guidance on a daily basis. I take my dreams

mountains of Pagosa Springs, Colorado, and from the top floor high rise buildings on the tiny Island of Manhattan. Writing can take you to out of town conventions and even to new countries for inspiration. I always feel that travel is a part of the job. After all, how could I write about the majestic black and gold sand of Maui if I have never been?

A writer's income is limitless. When I worked a 9 to 5 job, I mostly did so for the dependable monthly check. That's why many of us do it. The only downside to that monthly check was that it was exactly the same no matter how little or how much I worked. I didn't get paid for my effort I got paid for showing up. Writers understand that the more we work, the more passive income we can expect. I love to make money while I'm sleeping, especially when its a result of a labor of love, as I'm sure you would too. I'm not confined to a specific number of hours and pay. Writers make their own money rules.

Writers leave a written legacy. I love the idea of someone reading my books 100 years from now and enjoying them as much, if not more, than readers do today. Books and written stories live on even after our physical bodies expire. I am mentored by men and women who lived more than 100 years ago because they left behind their written legacy. If it's important to you to leave your mark in this world, your words are a great way of doing just that. My great, great, great grand-kids will know who I am and who they come from, through reading my books and stories. That is so exciting!

Writers, dreamers, doers, creators and innovators are HAPPY. Don't ever let anyone convince you that doing something you love is a waste of time. I wrote when there was no money to be made, just for the love of it. I've taught classes for free and collaborated on some amazing projects for free because this is what I LOVE. I give away my creativity to the world generously and I am generously compensated. Not just with money

but with love, friendships, connections, freedom and everything else that's AMAZING in life. Time and peace are so important to me. My days are full of peaceful moments and I always have time for my daughters. I'm sure you want more time with family and friends too. Writers have freedom. I love when readers tell me they learned something from my books or that my stories helped them through a rough patch. I am grateful for the opportunity and happy that I never gave up on becoming a better writer.

Whether it is a sixty-page e-book or a four hundred-page novel, the feeling of completion instills a certain level of excitement and pride (the good kind) in us. The confidence then transfers over into the services we provide for our clients. We become clear on our offerings and clear on why we feel our businesses or brand is so important.

Credibility is a huge part of building a brand or business. Credibility is shown in customer reviews,

quality websites and the availability of a book or blog. Clients see you as a person or business they can trust. With so many options related to businesses and services, consumers want to be sure they are choosing someone who will do exactly what they say, charge a reasonable price and be available for future questions and consultations. Clients want to feel that they can depend on you.

**Establishing yourself as a go-to expert is next-level branding.** After people understand that you are credible and competent, becoming an expert is only natural. That event changed me. It changed me for the BETTER.
